2. The First party shall charge emolument based on the type of service requested by the Second Party.
3. The first party shall submit an invoice upon completion of the assignment/ task.
4. First party will provide available analytical facilities to the second party during the execution of services. Professional Fees/ Charges and TAT (Turn around Time) for providing these services by the first party to the second party shall be as per mentioned in the **Annexure-1**, while in some cases it can be mutually agreed in writing on case to case, project and assignment basis.

Second Party:

1. The Second party based on their requirements shall refer forensic related cases to the first party.
2. The Second party shall release the referral fees to the first party based on the payment of the client and as per the invoices received.
3. The Second party shall in future also collaborate with the first party for forensics services, training and consultancy to various industries and companies.
4. The Second party will help in placement and paid internship for the students of the first party.

The above MOU can be modified, amended and extended with mutual written consent and agreement only.

Now, it is hereby mutually agreed by and between the parties as follows:

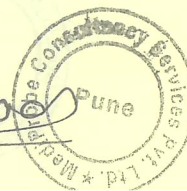
DEFINITIONS AND HEADINGS

In this MOU the following expressions shall have the following meanings unless the content otherwise require:

- The "MOU" means this MOU signed between the parties.
- The "Territory" means the country of operation i.e. India.
- The "Business" means the operations and the activities throughout the Territory.
- The "Contract" means jobs received in the Territory.
- The "Customer" means a party in the Territory who has awarded a Contract for execution of work and who receives the relevant services or products.

TAXES


Both the parties will be responsible for their respective liabilities arising out of this MOU towards payment of taxes and duties in India & the Territory, and will indemnify the other in this respect.

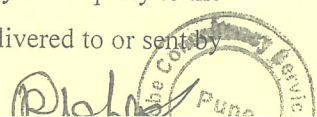
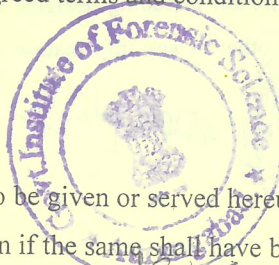
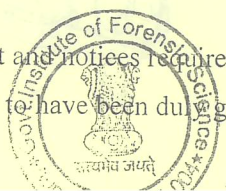
RIGHT OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Mediprobe Consultancy Services Private Limited, Pune


